

#### **Criteria to Evaluate Paulist Foundations and Ministries**

February 1, 2024

Paulists are a Society of Apostolic Life with a history of listening to the Holy Spirit and responding to the signs of the times. Like most of the North American church, the number of Paulists available today has returned to the level it was in the early 1900's. It is neither just nor good stewardship to ask half as many people to fulfill the same number of ministries as existed 20 years ago.

To respond to these changes and to ensure the Paulists Fathers can continue to provide the level of ministry and pastoral support for which they are known, a review of all ministries is under way. As a follow up to the mandate from the 2022 General Assembly the General Council drafted four criteria to evaluate Paulist foundations and ministries today and for the future.

#### 1 Paulist mission and charism

- 1.1 How does this ministry help us to fulfill our mission now and in the next 5 years?
- 1.2 How does this ministry allow us to live our charism now and in the next 5 years?

### **2** Caring for Paulist Fathers

- 2.1 Do we have Paulists capable of leading this ministry today? In 5 years?
- 2.2 Do we have Paulists willing to lead this ministry today? In 5 years?
- 2.3 Do we have 2 or more men to live in community?
- 2.4 Can we care for our SMS Fathers here?
- 2.5 How many Paulist vocations has this ministry produced in the past ten years?
- 2.6 What is the level of Episcopal support for this ministry?

### 3 Care for the People Served by Paulists

- 3.1 How many people do we serve? Use the status animarium or equivalent for 2021-2023
- 3.2 Do we have a special ministry to those on the periphery?
- 3.3 If we leave, who can continue to serve these people? Is there a natural partner to continue the ministry?

### 4 Financial Viability

- 4.1 What are the revenue and expenses for this ministry for the past three years?
- 4.2 What does this ministry contribute to the Paulists' appeal? Donors and dollars
- 4.3 What did this ministry contribute to the capital campaign? Donors and dollars
- 4.4 Do we own property? If yes, what capital improvements are needed?
